They must be disposed at designated disposal centers or returned to retail locations. ● Computers will not be collected at recycling stations. 	NOTES Long, burnable items (over 1m) must be cut (under 50cm in length / 5 cm in width) · Excess string & fabric should be cut to under 2m. Large volumes of waste, exceeding typical output, should always be brought directly to the Environment Beautification Center. In the event that burnable, non-burnable and recycling items are not separated, a handling fee will be charged for all of it.
